PRESENTATION OF GRANT FROM THE SOUTHERN NEVADA CHAPTER OF THE INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL

Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN invited CHRIS KNIGHT, Director of Building and Safety to the podium. MR. KNIGHT presented the City with a grant in the amount of \$1500 from the Southern Nevada Chapter of the International Code Council (ICC). The ICC is a group consisting of building officials, building inspectors, private contractors and consultants who work together to develop building codes to ensure safety in buildings and structures. Pool safety is also very important to the ICC and the funds from this grant will go towards scholarships for swimming lessons for toddlers and the prevention of drowning.
