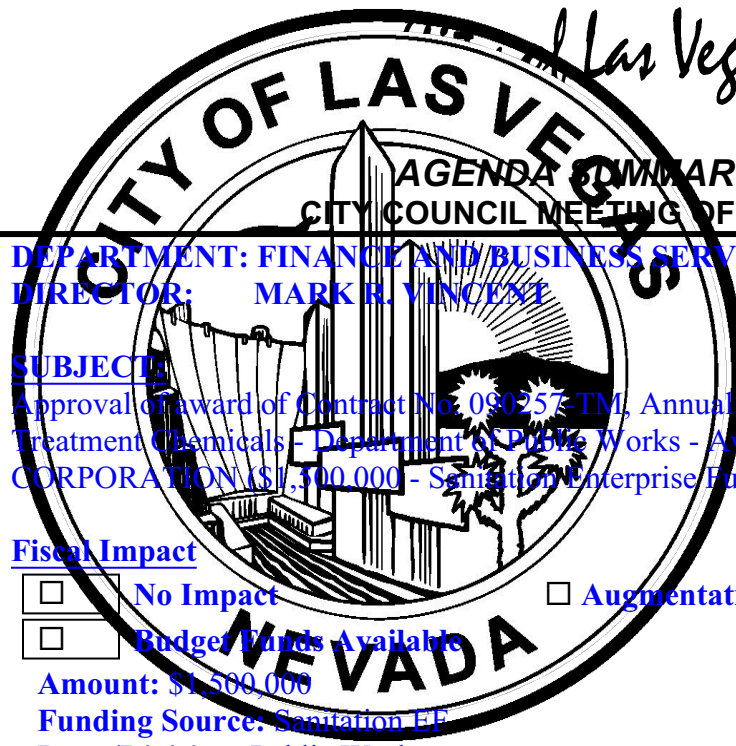

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

This contract is one of three Annual Requirements Contracts that provide for water treatment chemicals for use at the Water Pollution Control Facility. The City of Las Vegas was the principal procurement agency for the National Intergovernmental Purchasing Alliance (NIPA) for this competitive Request for Proposal which is resulting in a contract award for two polymer chemicals for the City and six polymer blended chemicals available on a national contract for any State or local government agency to join. The City will receive an annual rebate payment from NIPA attributable to the marketing of this water treatment national agreement.
