Minutes:

CAROL MEYER, Supervisor of Business Services, noted that several chiropractic businesses were applying for ancillary massage licenses in response to the change in State law. Chiropractic assistants are no longer allowed to perform massage and all massage therapists are required to be licensed by the State Board of Massage Therapy. The applicant has met the criteria for temporary approval of this license. The square footage devoted to massage will be less than 150 square feet and no exterior signage shall be permitted. The applicant has agreed to perform massage during the normal hours of operation of the chiropractic business. She recommended

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approval subject to conditions.

DR. MARCIA TINBERG was present and agreed to all conditions.
