PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to the First Amended Power Supply Agreement between the Colorado River Commission (CRC) and the Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) as defined in NRS 704.787, the CRC has been authorized to provide electric services to SNWA and its member agencies for water and wastewater operations. The City of Las Vegas being a member agency desires CRC to provide sufficient power supply assets to meet electrical needs of the city's wastewater treatment facilities. The Service Agreement allows NV Energy as the transmission service provider and scheduling coordinator, to provide unbundled transmission services and scheduled delivery of power utilizing NV Energy's transmission assets.
