PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Letter of Agreement and Transmission Reduction Plan defines the obligations and actions of NV Energy, the transmission provider and the scheduling coordinator, to help preserve system delivery reliability in the event where NV Energy is unable to obtain and schedule sufficient resources or in the event of an emergency where loads are required to be reduced to match resources to help prevent blackouts. The Transmission Reduction Plan identifies the loads at the wastewater facilities as Tier 1, being critical to the health, safety and welfare of Southern Nevada and allows the city to curtail loads in a manner that is least disruptive to the wastewater treatment facilities operations while complying with the plan requirements.
