PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On May 6, 2008, a Master Interlocal Agreement was approved between the County of Clark and the City of Las Vegas to fund certain LVMPD capital projects outside the normal operating budget of the department. These projects are to be funded through separate supplemental Interlocal Agreements that must comply with the master agreement. This Interlocal Agreement is for the funding of the expansion of the LVMPD Metrocomm Facility. The City's share of the project cost is calculated based on the funding formula is \$2,139,283.78 (Refer to Exhibit A for a breakdown of projected costs).
