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Minutes:

JIM DiFIORE, Manager of Business Services, noted the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (Metro) investigative report had been provided to the Council and highlighted the areas of concern. He recommended approval of the temporary license with a six-month review and a condition requiring that Metro notify the City of any altercations that take place.

ATTORNEY MATTHEW DUSHOFF, 3520 West Sahara Avenue, appeared on behalf of the applicants and agreed to the conditions as recommended by staff, as well as the condition requiring the applicants to take anger management classes.

COUNCILMAN ROSS stated that after reading the report, he could not support the license request.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN expressed concern with the applicants' pattern of behavior and suggested that they be required to take anger management classes. COUNCILMAN WOLFSON suggested that they take the classes offered through Municipal Court. COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN requested a summary from the Court at the completion of the course.

COUNCILMAN REESE was uncomfortable supporting the mandatory condition requiring the applicants take anger management classes. CITY ATTORNEY BRAD JERBIC stated that ATTORNEY DUSHOFF indicated that his clients would agree to the condition of the mandatory anger management class.
