NOTE: COUNCILMAN REESE disclosed that his daughter is an employee of NV Energy but that would have no impact on his ability to vote on Items 87-89. ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY BRYAN SCOTT indicated that COUNCILMAN REESE was being consistent with what he has done in the past.

MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing open for Items 87-89.

AUGUST 19, 2009

EDGAR PATINO and MICHELLE BALTZ, 6226 West Sahara Avenue, appeared on behalf of the applicant. MR. PATINO clarified that the Planning Commission had unanimously recommended approval of the General Plan Amendment and related applications.

MS. BALTZ explained that in June 2009, the northwest substation was annexed and the zoning was subsequently changed. In order to complete the expansion of the substation, the zoning must once again be changed for the five acres situated on the southwest corner of the parcel. She displayed the site plan, indicating the addition of new lines.

Regarding the Site Development Plan Review, ROBERT PERSON, Public Works, recommended deletion of Condition 16 as it duplicates Condition 12 and read an additional condition relative to the right-of-way grant easement. MS. BALTZ concurred.

MAYOR GOODMAN announced the Public Hearing closed for Items 87-89.
