PROJECT DESCRIPTIONS:

1. Doolittle Park Renovation Phase 2

Amount Requested: \$250,000

Constructed in 1965 and encompassing 18 acres, Doolittle Park is located west of Martin Luther King Drive, south of West Lake Mead Boulevard on the east side of J Street. The park is in a deteriorating condition due to consistent heavy use. A Phase 1 of the project was approved in Round 10 for \$1.4 million and is the portion of the park abutting J Street, which includes an open lawn area and a walking trail. Renovation of this phase will include re-location of the existing tot lot with a new shade structure as well as an entry treatment of the area where the tot lot was originally.

2. Trail Markers & Signage/Trailhead Signage

Amount Requested: \$250,000

The City of Las Vegas is requesting funding to provide mileage markers and associated trailhead signage for local trails within its jurisdiction. The trail markers would likely become part of an overall emergency system tied into police and fire services. A recent regional effort has established trail mileage markers/trailhead signage standards.
