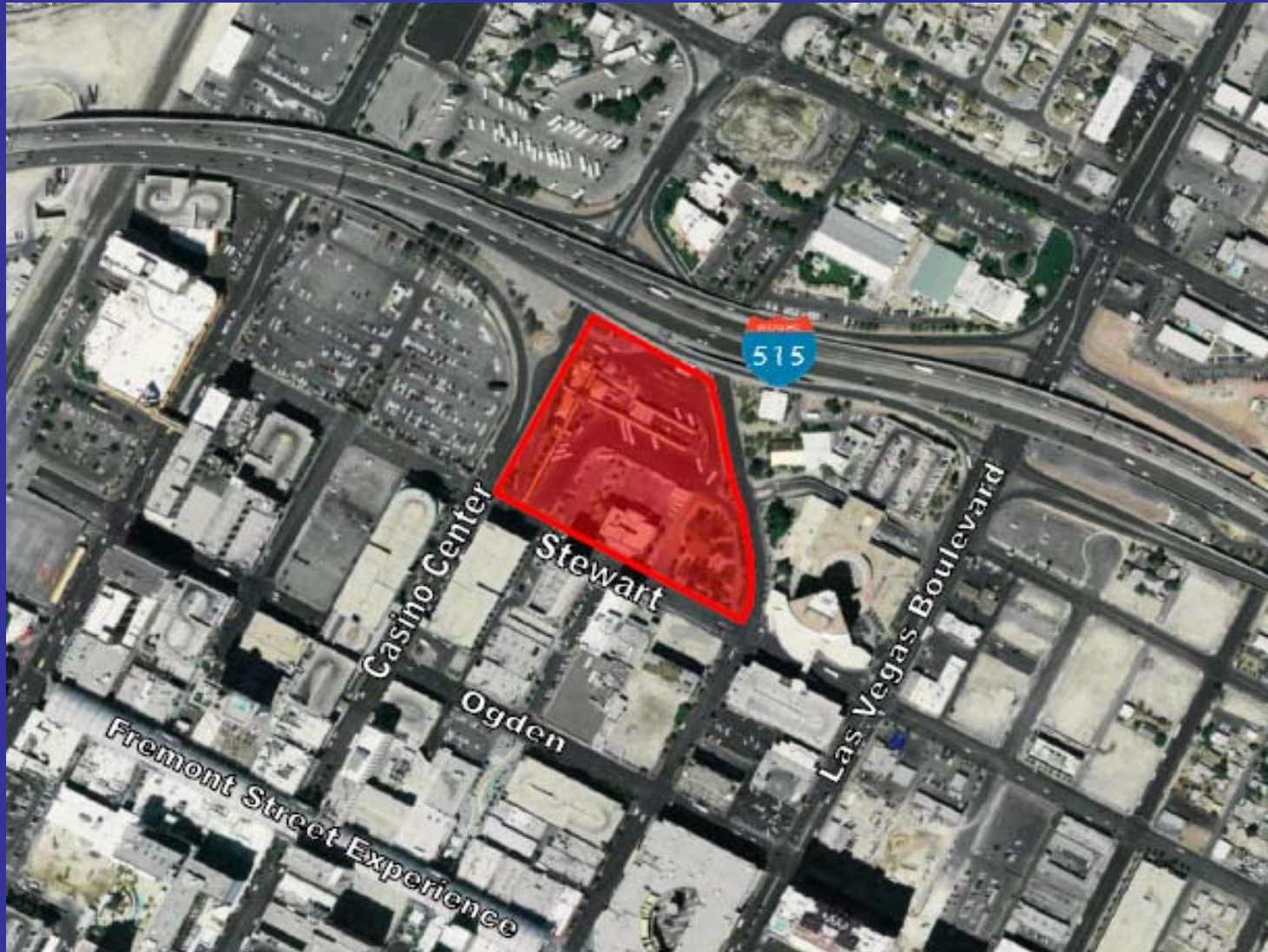

PROPOSED TID BOUNDARIES



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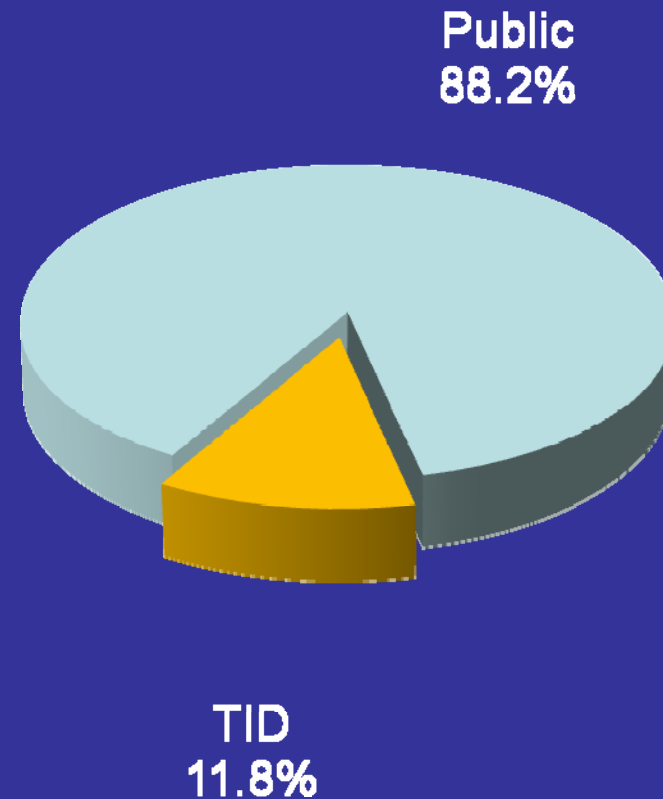


-  U.S. Post Office & Courthouse Parcel

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- Supports a public-private partnership to attract \$247M in new development
 - Fiscal Benefit – Generates new taxes from property currently off the tax roll, with a net benefit of \$5.4M
 - Creates a revenue stream of \$3.1M per year to help fund public improvements – public parking, streetscape improvements
 - Supports City's investment in Las Vegas Museum of Organized Crime and Law Enforcement

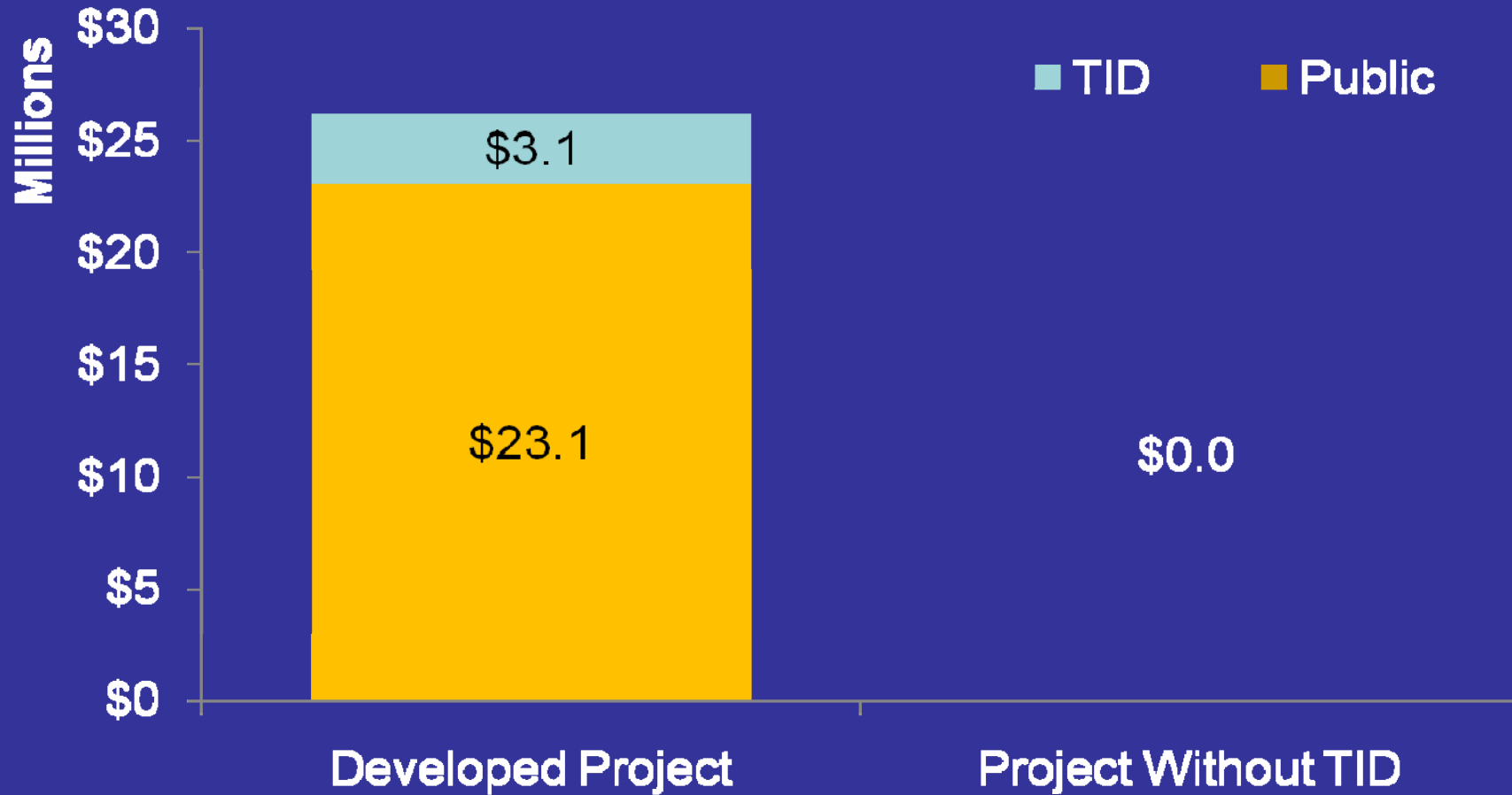
PUBLIC REVENUES WITH TID PROJECT

- \$26.1 million in recurring annual public revenue
- \$23.1 million will be distributed to various public entities as required by law
- \$3.1 million will be invested in public infrastructure within the District



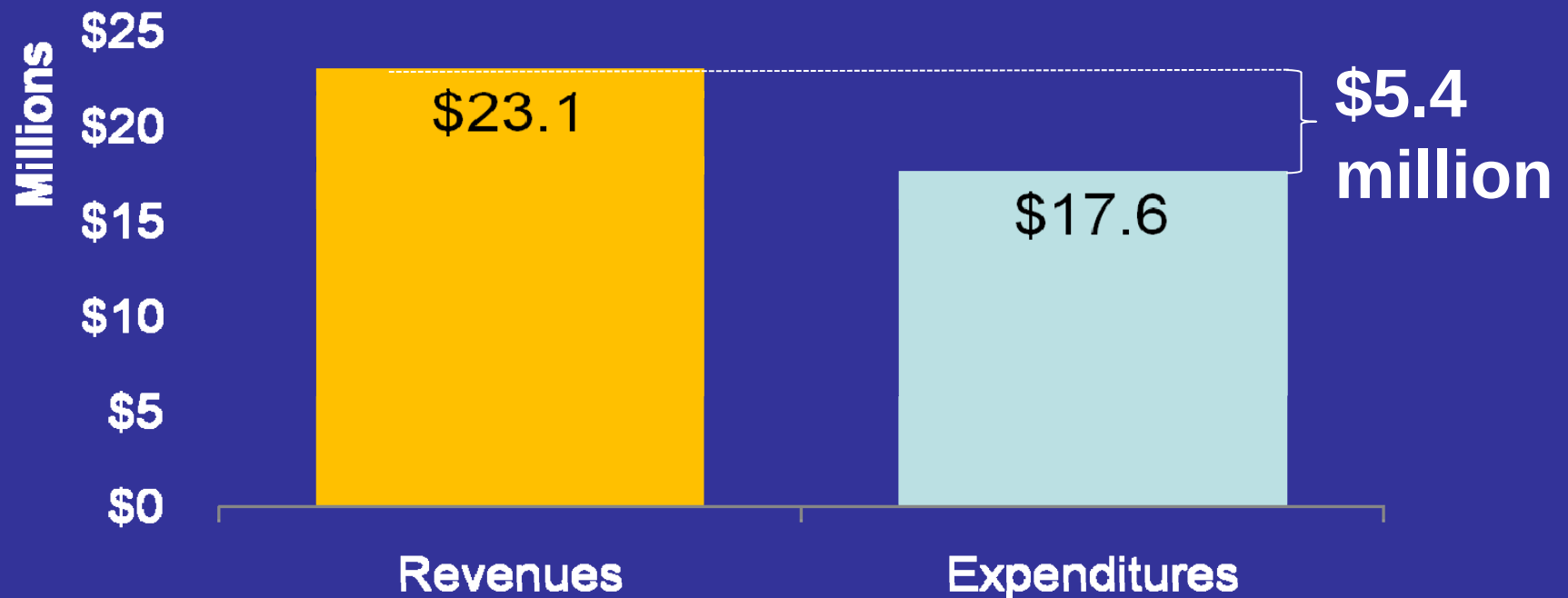
PUBLIC REVENUES:
