PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Traffic Engineering Division received a request to install speed humps on Dalecrest Drive between Gowan Road and Alexander Road. An 85th percentile speed of at least 35 mph and a volume of 800 vehicles per day are needed to meet the criteria for speed humps. Studies conducted on this street showed that the 85th percentile speed was 39 mph and the volume of traffic was 1425 vehicles per day. A total of 40 points is recommended for the installation of speed humps and Dalecrest Drive accumulated 43 points. Staff is therefore recommending approval of the speed humps. This street is not an emergency response route.
