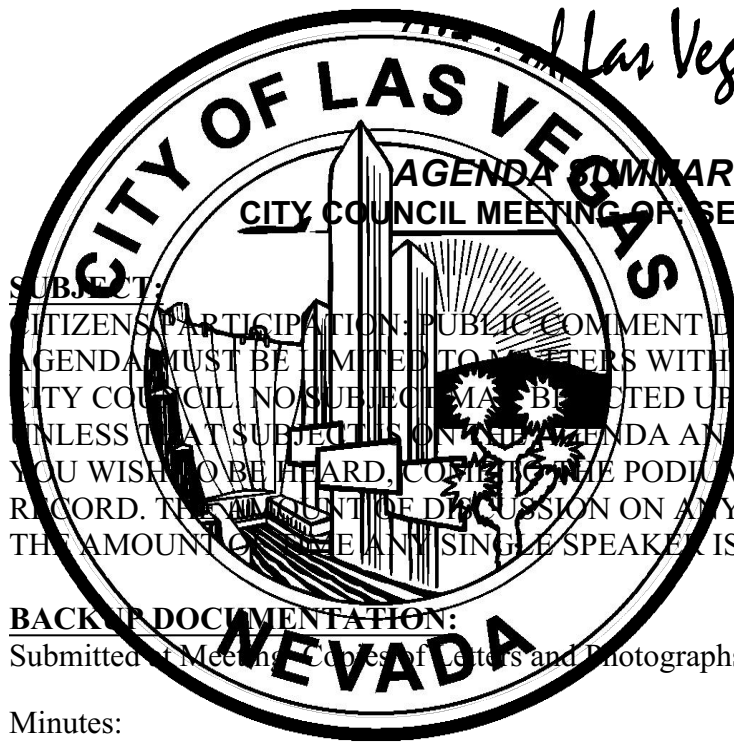

Minutes:

ANTHONY HODGES commented that the Cleveland Clinic is world renowned and one of the finest heart facilities in the world. He urged citizens to love this nation and for those who receive naturalization to be proud of becoming a citizen. He and his wife celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary.

TIM MURPHY spoke on property on Ann Road and Jones Boulevard that is a County island surrounded by the city property. He expressed concern over the previous actions that have taken relative to the zoning and asked if there was an avenue in which the residents can present their case. COUNCILMAN ROSS emphasized that the property is County and an annexation to the City would need to occur first. He offered to meet with MR. MURPHY and pointed out that there is an interlocal agreement, which determined these uses as spot zoning.

TEDDY RUSSELL suggested having a pedestrian footbridge from the National History Museum to the Las Vegas Library. He cautioned everyone regarding pride. He saw the Lou Ruvo Brain Institute as a blessing and noted this is a beautiful time of year to visit Las Vegas.

TODD FARLOW asked for the reason why Items 80 and 81 were withdrawn from the agenda. COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN explained that the applicant is working with Neighborhood Services, and she was informed by one of the representatives that the plan is to build a smaller development.

MR. FARLOW complimented the street improvements done on Third Street. MAYOR GOODMAN agreed and thanked him for the comments.

MAYOR GOODMAN invited EMILY SANDOVAL to the podium, who was present to observe the meeting for her political science class. Although MS. SANDOVAL did not understand some of the formalities, she liked the meeting and MAYOR GOODMAN explained to her the process for applicants seeking approval of their items. He invited her to attend the AM Session. MS. SANDOVAL informed COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN that she is involved in a program called Step Up at Mojave High School and her teacher is MR. JONES.
