MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing open.

COUNCILMAN REESE requested this item be pulled from the One Motion/One Vote calendar for discussion.

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JOHN RYAN was present and confirmed that he understood all of the conditions, including the prohibition of parked vehicles on site and no motor replacements.

COUNCILMAN REESE apologized for the four-month delay, but he desired to speak with the applicant prior to any decision being made on this application due to his previous concerns at this location. Since the abeyance, the Councilman has spoken with the applicant about those concerns. The request is to open up a garage with minor repairs.

MARGO WHEELER, Director of Planning and Development, read the additional condition pertaining to the hours of operation, and confirmed for the Councilman that the Special Use Permit would be effective immediately upon approval.
