"Flo TV" provides wireless TV viewing on your cell phone.

Flo TV has approached the City of Las Vegas regarding a Zoning Change to allow an antenna, along with 2 small satellite dishes and support equipment at or on the existing radio tower that sits on BLM property which is located south of Charleston Ave. East of Buffalo, and North of Del Rey Ave. (It's the area that has the large radio antenna just East of the new Social Security building on Buffalo.)

In the city's master plan this property is currently zoned "Desert Rural". This means that only homes can be built here if the BLM ever sells the property and the radio tower is removed.

The city's current zoning laws will require this land to be re-zoned to "Public Facilities" in order to allow Flo TV to put up the equipment. This change in zoning is the only way Flo TV can use the proposed site. "Public Facilities" zoning means that any of the following could be built on this property (Note, this is not a complete list):

Government Building(s) of any kind

Police Station or Fire Station

School

Shooting range (included to illustrate the broad range allowable in this zoning designation)

Ward 2 Councilman Steve Wolfson, has asked that we survey local residents to gauge their acceptance of this proposed zoning change.

Councilman Wolfson feels that he might be able to get "Flow TV" to do some "improvements" at the site, which may be in the form of a "chain link fence" in place of the existing barbed wire fencing and some "asphalt curbing" or "pathway" along Del Rey Ave. A gate would be installed for purposes of blocking the access road, which borders the east edge of the BLM property and Crystal Canyon Estates. This gate may help in preventing dumping of trash in this area.

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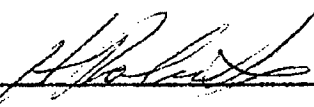

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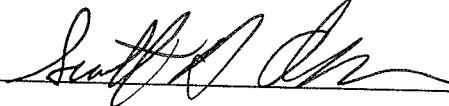

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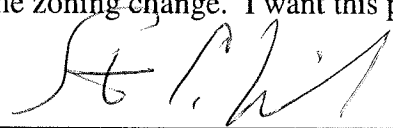
