Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing open.

SHANE HENNESSY-YORK, 7030 Smoke Ranch Road, appeared on behalf of the applicant. He displayed on the overhead a plot plan while explaining that the proposed cell tower will be situated between two self-storage facilities and is designed for future collocation if desired.

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COUNCILMAN REESE objected to having two poles on the same property and suggested tearing down the existing one. MR. HENNESSY-YORK replied that the existing one is older, so it would cause decreased reception. The Councilman pointed out that the existing carrier has yet to collocate, which he agrees with, and does not believe this location is the most suitable.

MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing closed.
