THEREFORE; We, the Mayor and Members of the Las Vegas City Council, do hereby take great pride in proclaiming October 21, 2009, as:

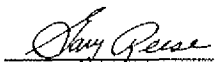

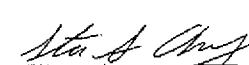
