4 AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF A MOBILE BILLBOARD WITHIN FIVE
5 HUNDRED FEET OF A SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLING, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER
RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Prohibits the parking of a mobile
billboard within five hundred feet of a single-
family dwelling.

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8 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
9 AS FOLLOWS:

10 SECTION 1: Title 11, Chapter 52, Section 305, of the Municipal Code of the City of
11 Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 **11.52.305:** (A) It is unlawful for a person to stand, park or store, upon any residential street,
13 a commercial vehicle, recreational vehicle, trailer, or any combination of vehicle and trailer having
14 an overall length of twenty-four feet or more, except in front of property from which or to which
15 goods or passengers are being picked up or delivered, and then only for that period of time during
16 which goods or passengers are being expeditiously loaded or unloaded.

17 (B) It is unlawful for a person to stand, park or store a mobile billboard upon any
18 street at a location within five hundred feet of a single-family dwelling. For purposes of this
19 Subsection (B), "mobile billboard" means one or more sign structures that are mounted on a vehicle
20 or trailer and are used for general advertising or advertising for hire. The term does not include signs
21 that are displayed or installed on:

22 (1) A bus, taxicab or similar vehicle that is used primarily for the purpose
23 of transporting multiple passengers; or

24 (2) A vehicle operated in the normal course of the vehicle owner's business,
25 if the signs contain advertising or identifying information directly related to the business and are not
26 used to display advertising unrelated to that business.

27 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
28 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or

1 ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
2 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
3 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
4 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
5 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,
6 invalid or ineffective.

7 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
8 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
9 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
