PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

In September 2003, the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition (SNRPC) Board adopted a Homeless Intervention Proposal and created the Committee on Homeless (CoH) in an effort to address the needs of homeless persons in Southern Nevada. The SNRPC Committee on Homeless has undertaken several significant tasks relating to the regional issue of homelessness, including the establishment of inclement weather shelter as well as regional coordination. The total cost of this effort, \$1,068,975, will be shared among all local government entities on a population-based formula. The city of Las Vegas investment to this regional effort for fiscal year 2009-2010 is \$331,382.25. These funds will be used to support and implement programs and services such as regional homeless coordination, inclement weather shelter, HMIS, and the homeless shelter and street count.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the agreement and authorizes the Mayor to execute any and all agreements upon approval as to form by the City Attorney.
