*We urge all citizens of Las Vegas to join with us in celebrating diversity and recognize Native American Heritage in our great city.*



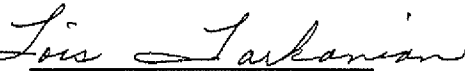

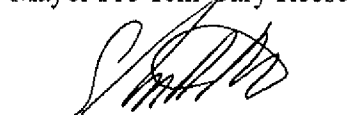

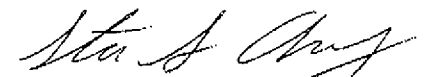
