PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On November 19, 2008 City Council approved Agenda item #24 for the construction of approximately 13,600 linear feet of a multi-use trail, a trail head and pedestrian bridge. This modification includes: additional riprap along the channel to reinforce the natural drainage and protect the new bridge structure; funds for utility conflicts and utility service extensions; retaining wall and drainage installation and other related work.
