

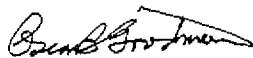

- THEREFORE;* We, the Mayor and Members of the Las Vegas City Council, do hereby take great pride in proclaiming December 2, 2009, as

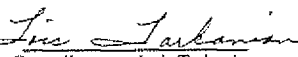

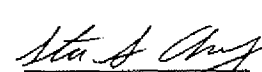
