PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Symphony Park is a master planned community. The intent of City Parkway V, Inc., has been to turn the operations and maintenance of the project over to an association once the association becomes the majority land owner. The Community Charter for Symphony Park creates the Master Association, a nonprofit corporation organized pursuant to the provisions of Title 7, Chapter 82, Nevada Revised Statutes. Membership in the association is granted via parcel ownership and is entitled to vote.
