Extension of Time Justification for Far Hills Substation and Transmission Line U-119-98

NV Energy has approval from the City of Las Vegas for two electrical substations, the Beltway Substation and the Far Hills Substation, and associated transmission lines located on the north side of Far Hills Way and west of the Western Beltway. The Beltway Substation, located on APN. 137-26-201-001, has been constructed as have the transmission lines connecting into said substation. The Far Hills Substation, to be located on APN. 137-27-601-002 has not been constructed, nor has the overhead transmission line that would connect the Beltway substation to the Far Hills substation.

The community growth hasn't materialized as anticipated; therefore, it has not been necessary to construct the Far Hills Substation and transmission line. The City of Las Vegas approval for the Far Hills Substation and transmission line is set to expire on November 23, 2009 and NV Energy is respectfully requesting a four year extension of time for said facilities.
