**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

This agreement between Clark County and the City of Las Vegas provides for reimbursement of \$41,064 for funds to conduct programming relative to the DHS FFY09/Statewide Citizens Corps Program. Expenditures eligible for reimbursement include Planning CERT Support Staff; Planning OEM Personnel Cost Share; Equipment Printer; Generator Inverter CCP Support NLE; and Planning MVP.

Minutes:

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN indicated that residents questioned this item, and she was briefed by the City Manager that anyone in the State can apply for the Citizens Corps Program. It is a State program operated through the City.

CITY MANAGER ELIZABETH FRETWELL asked TED OLIVAS, Director of Administrative Services, and CAROLYN LEVERING, Emergency Management Officer, to provide detailed information, noting that the City is doing this on behalf of the Region for funds that are passed from the Federal Government to the State.

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MS. LEVERING explained that the Citizens Corps Council is an initiative at the national level that formulates grant funds that are passed through states and onto local government. The City of Las Vegas has used these funds to promote citizen preparedness and awareness. The Community Emergency Response Team is funded through this program. There is a statewide Citizen Corps Council that promotes these projects, and membership on that council is appointed through the Governor's office. City staff is part of that council, along with private sector and other non-profit organization groups that help prepare and arrange for programs throughout Clark County and the State of Nevada. Anyone interested should call the office of Emergency Management at 229-0313. There are at large positions on the Statewide Citizen Corps Council.
