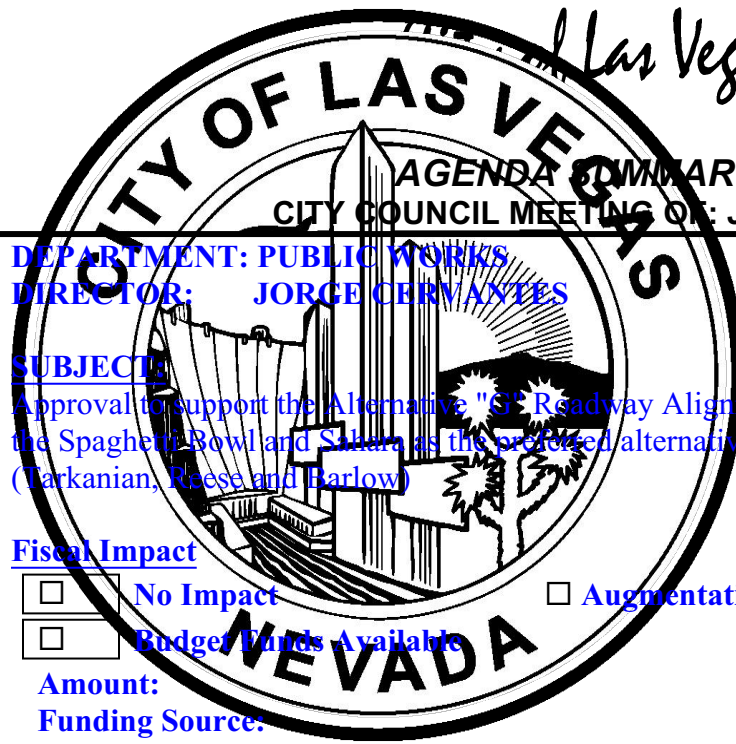

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

Project Neon is a freeway improvement project that will address short- and long-term transportation needs for the busy stretch of the I-15 corridor from Sahara Avenue to the Spaghetti Bowl interchange. The project objectives include improving traffic operations, improving safety by addressing congestion-related incidents, providing better access to area neighborhoods and businesses, and providing a connection between the proposed high occupancy vehicle (HOV) lanes on I-15 and the HOV lanes on US-95. Based on analysis to date and public comment, Alternative G has been identified as the preferred alternative for Project Neon. The project is moving forward in the development of a Final Environmental Impact Statement and Record of Decision. The Record of Decision is anticipated in Spring 2010.
