Minutes:

TODD FARLOW, Las Vegas resident, asked the reason for the withdrawal without prejudice of Items 67 and 68. He felt the proposal of cell towers within existing structures was a great idea. If this particular proposal does not work, the Planning Commission needs to know.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW responded that in lieu of adding the antenna to the northeast corner adjacent to residential properties, he asked that the antenna be moved across the street to a vacant lot adjacent to the school and a church. He did not want to take the antenna higher and having it impede upon the residents. MR. FARLOW stated it is important that the City Council be made aware of this.

ANTHONY HODGES, Las Vegas resident, stated that many items are approved with one motion, but some items need to be discussed individually because the public has the right to speak on items.
