PROGRAM AREA: 8. SURVEY

Historic Resource Survey and Inventory of the Beverly Green neighborhood has been revised to the Phase II: Historic Resource Survey and Inventory of the Southridge Neighborhood. The scope of work for the 2008 HPF grant needed to be divided into two phases due to the awarded amount and time allowed for the project. The 2010 HPF grant application includes completion of the Phase I: Historic Resource Survey and Inventory of the Beverly Green neighborhood.

Funding is requested for a qualified historic preservation consultant's fees to complete the second phase of an intensive level historic resource survey of the Southridge Neighborhood. The Southridge Neighborhood is a registered neighborhood association with the city of Las Vegas Neighborhood Services Department and has definable boundaries as such (please see attached map for visual reference).

The survey area is generally bounded by Oakey Boulevard to the north, E. St. Louis Avenue to the south, S. Tenth Street to the west, and S. Maryland Parkway to the east. The survey area includes several small housing tracts. The survey area contains approximately 186 homes that are over fifty years old. The predominant architectural style is modern Ranch.

Survey of this area is part of the overall recommendation by the city of Las Vegas Historic Preservation Commission to develop a Mid-Century Historic Context Report for WWII and post-WWII development within the city of Las Vegas.

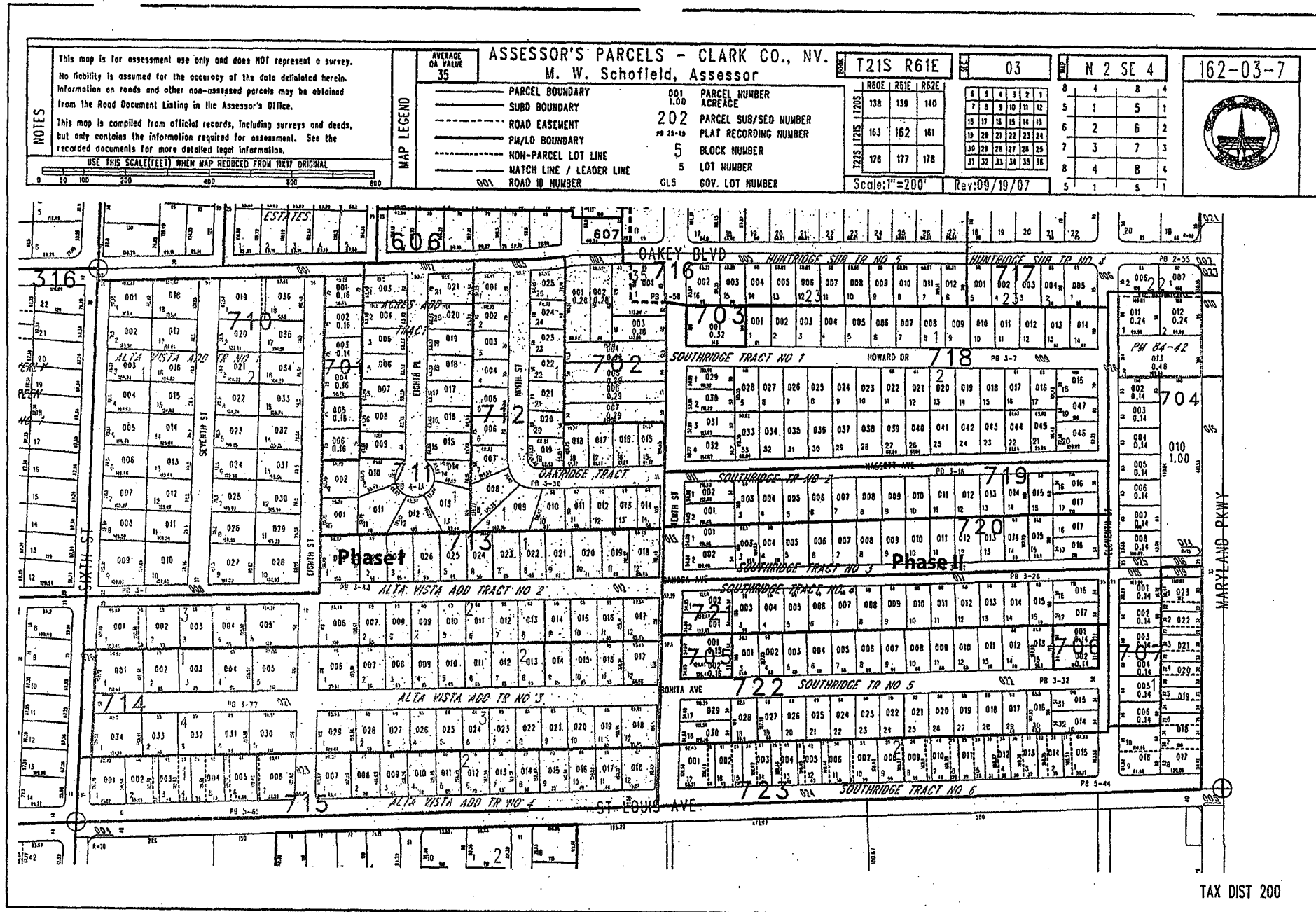
