PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This Resolution consents and supports the efforts of the Nevada Department of Transportation to develop and construct Project Neon and the selection of Alternative G as the preferred alternative which includes the following roadway improvements: I-15 Freeway capacity improvements (widening), a median viaduct from US-95 at Rancho Drive to I-15 at Symphony Park Avenue and I-15 HOV lanes through the Sahara Avenue Interchange, reconstruction of freeway ramps to improve safety and operations, interchange improvements including reconstruction of the Charleston Boulevard Interchange and an exit ramp to Alta Drive-Bonneville Avenue, a six-lane arterial viaduct connecting Industrial Road and Martin L. King Boulevard, street improvements primarily affecting Western Avenue, Grand Central Parkway, Desert Lane, Alta Drive-Bonneville Avenue, Oakey-Wyoming Avenue, Sahara Avenue, Bearden Drive, Wall Street, Shadow Lane, and Iron Horse Loop, and utility and flood control facility reconstruction.
