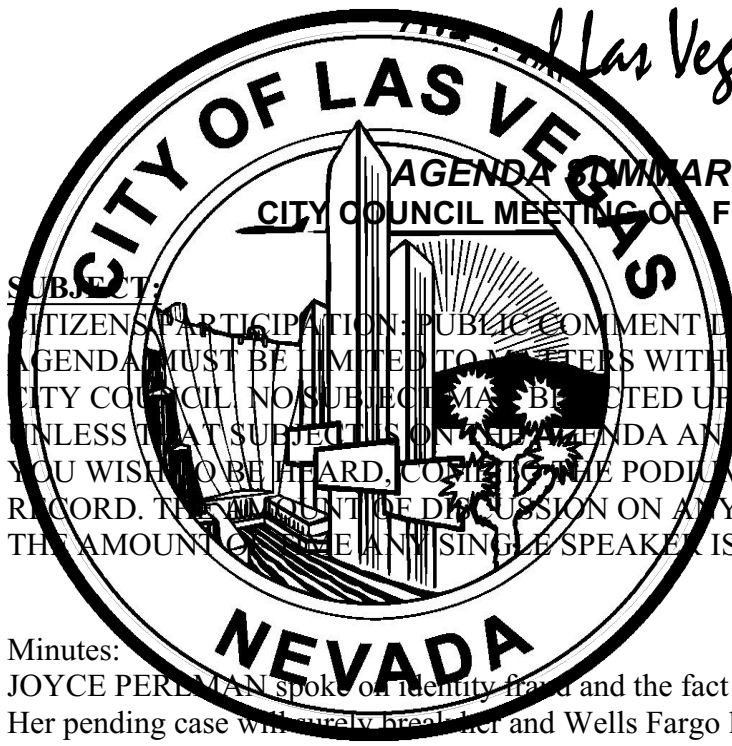




**SUBJECT:**
