Minutes:

JIM DiFIORE, Business Services Manager, indicated the applicant has been operating under an extended administrative temporary license for the past six months. The applicant's background report revealed some negative activity; however, she is attempting to give back to society and

assist young children with self-esteem issues. Staff was willing to move forward with an extension of the temporary license subject to conditions.

KEYONZIA HARDER gave a brief history on her background experience. Having idle time in the past, she made some mistakes and is now trying to give back to society. She uses her own money to finance tournaments for kids to assist them with discipline and self-esteem.

MR. DiFIORE read the conditions into the record and clarified for the Council that the current temporary license expires in June, and this request will be for an extension of that license, which will then expire in December; at that time, a review would take place. There have been no incidents since MS. HARDER has had the temporary license. For COUNCILMAN BARLOW, MS. HARDER confirmed her acceptance of all of the conditions.
