ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER OR A DESIGNEE, RATHER THAN THE CITY COUNCIL, TO WAIVE ORDINANCE REQUIREMENTS PERTAINING TO THE UNDERGROUNDING OF ELECTRICAL AND SIMILAR DISTRIBUTION LINES UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Authorizes the City Manager or a
designee to waive ordinance requirements
pertaining to the undergrounding of electrical
and similar distribution lines.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 13, Chapter 52, Section 170, of the Municipal Code of the City of
Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.52.170: (A) An application may be made to the Director of Public Works requesting approval [by the City Council] of a waiver of the requirements of this Chapter pertaining to underground installation of distribution lines for any of the following reasons:

(1) In cases of emergency where public health and safety would be jeopardized;

(2) Unavailability of materials necessary for underground installation;

(3) Topographical or subsurface conditions making such underground installations economically unreasonable or impractical; or

(4) Requiring the underground installation does not promote the purposes stated under Section 13.52.010 or is unreasonable due to other circumstances presented by the applicant.

(B) Except as otherwise provided in Subsection (C), [The] the application shall be reviewed by the Director of Public Works who shall make recommendations for approval or denial to the City Council. After reviewing the recommendations of the Director of Public Works, the City Council shall approve the application if it comes within one of the categories set out in Subsection (A)

1 of this Section for which a waiver may be granted to the applicant.

2 (C) The City Manager or the City Manager's designee may grant a waiver under
3 this Section if the City Manager determines that an administrative-level waiver is appropriate, given
4 the nature and scope of the application.

5 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or
6 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or
7 ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or
8 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the
9 City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
10 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections,
11 subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional,
12 invalid or ineffective.

13 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
14 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
15 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
