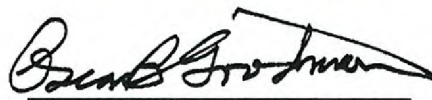

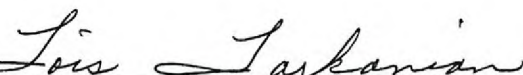
- Whereas;* the Irish Club at Sun City Summerlin was established in 1999 by Aileen Murphy Zsenyuk with the unfailing support of her husband Bill (aka Bill O'Zsenyuk). The Irish Club bills itself as "The Friendliest Club in Sun City"; and
- Whereas;* at the very first meeting of the Irish Club, about 35 interested residents joined and most of them are still members. The only requirement to be a member of the Club is that one must be a resident of Sun City Summerlin and have an interest in things that are Irish. For example, the current president is Hungarian and other members are English, Italian, Jewish, Asian, Scottish, and Greek; and
- Whereas;* the Irish Club presently has about 85 members and their meetings start with the Pledge of Allegiance, because Irish are proud to be Americans, and is followed by the singing of the Club song, "When Irish Eyes are Smiling"; and
- Whereas;* the Irish Club's events include a pub crawl (although they only manage to crawl to one pub), a Halloween costume party, beer tastings, Limerick contests, potlucks and casino nights. A very special event is held every March when the children from the Martin Percival School of Irish Dance perform to a packed audience. Every year, the Irish Club invites all the residents of Sun City Summerlin to see these wonderful young people perform; and
