PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This contract will provide for public outreach and communication services during the design phase of the F Street freeway interchange with an option for additional services during the construction phase. Due to the nature of the design and construction project, it was determined the City should contract with a consultant to provide feedback to the City, the residents affected by the construction project and the media outlets to ensure accurate information is disseminated to all parties. Funding for this capital project was originally transferred from the Redevelopment Agency.

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Minutes:

JORGE CERVANTES, Director of Public Works, and MARK VINCENT, Chief Financial Officer, were present. MR. CERVANTES, at the request of COUNCILMAN BARLOW, explained the purpose of Item 31 by summarizing the Subject and Purpose/Background sections.

MAYOR GOODMAN stated that community outreach in the F Street matter is of great import and requested that rather than contracting with Purdie Marion & Associates, the monies be redirected to create a City position and keep a current employee working. He mentioned that COUNCILMAN BARLOW said he discussed this matter at length.

CITY ATTORNEY BRAD JENKINS advised that a separate item would have to be placed on a future agenda to create a new position. CITY MANAGER ELIZABETH FRETWELL clarified that creation of a position is not necessary and that she would confer with DAVID RIGGLEMAN, Director of Communications, MR. VINCENT and MR. CERVANTES on how to fund the necessary activities for this project.

MR. VINCENT indicated that Item 32 could be acted on as it involves the engineering component.
