Minutes:

CAROL MEYER, Business Services Supervisor, summarized the applicant's background investigation and area of concern. She recommended a temporary license with a six-month review.

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HAITHAM BIDI and his brother, SAEB BIDI, were present. MR. H. BIDI asked why the permanent license was not being granted. MAYOR GOODMAN indicated that it was because there was an area of concern by Business Services. MS. MEYER rejoined that the area of concern involved the failure to disclose a sale of a California business to a brother. Staff would like to see how the business operates for six months.

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY agreed that six months would provide an opportunity for MESSRS. BIDI to prove themselves as businessmen in the City of Las Vegas.
