Minutes:

ANTHONY CHODURA pointed out that turning the gas off on a rental property that was discussed earlier in the meeting caused a problem for a woman that was on oxygen. Regarding the .vegas business venture, he regarded the abbreviation of Las Vegas as a disservice to the people of this community because the name is a jewel and it belongs to the people of this community.

TODD FARLOW recalled apartments located at the corner of Sunrise and Eastern Avenues that were condemned, and the owner was allowed to rehab the property on the condition that the money from the rents be applied toward bringing the buildings into code compliance. He wondered if that condition is still in effect. He attended a meeting at the East Las Vegas Community Center, where a developer expressed interest in developing the five corners at Eastern Avenue and Fremont Street. He hopes someone from City staff can make contact with that developer and make that development happen in order to get rid of blighted, boarded up buildings in the area. COUNCILMAN REESE indicated that he would get back to MR. FARLOW.

DENISE ROCKWAY suggested the Council put the homeless to work and clean up the homeless corridor and streets. This will make them productive citizens. The Council should seriously consider this because anyone, in today's economy, can become homeless.
