PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

On December 16, 2009 City Council approved Agenda item #30 for the construction of a new City park with passive walking and resting space adjacent to the City's historic Neon Boneyard. This modification will include water line relocation from the project site to Las Vegas Boulevard, half street improvements on Encanto Street, future conduit installation within Boneyard site, sewer abandonment within the project site, additional pavement work and extended removal and disposal of hazardous materials associated with historic neon signs.
