PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This program will allow developers and/or contractors for a limited time to apply for reissuance of expired offsite permits relating to infrastructure improvements at minimum fees. Currently offsite permits may be renewed prior to the expiration date printed on the permit without incurring additional permit fees. Once the permit has expired, all permit fees are due prior to any additional work being done. No inspections can be scheduled. The goal is to allow developers with expired permits to gain valid permits without incurring substantial additional cost.

RECOMMENDATION:

Public Works recommends approval subject to conformance with all City codes and departmental standards and off-site improvements.
