**ITEM DESCRIPTION: DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION
REGARDING THE EXPIRED PERMIT REISSUANCE PROGRAM FOR
OFFSITE PERMITS FOR MINIMUM PERMIT FEES ALL WARDS**

Temporary Procedure for Permit Renewals/Reissues effective from council adoption until December 31, 2010.

The OFFSITE PERMIT RENEWAL/REISSUE PROCEDURE will remain in effect with the exception of the requirement to update the bond to the current standard and the amount of permit fees for expired permits.

Update of bond to current standard

- Due to the economic impact of updating the bond to the current standard the City of Las Vegas has determined that it is in the best interest of the community to waive the requirement to update the bonding for a project to the current standard.
- The original agreed upon bond for any project can remain in effect throughout the course of the project if the permits are renewed prior to the expiration date and/or the permits are reissued prior to December 31, 2010 and remain in effect without interruption until project completion. Should the permits expire they will be subject to the expired permit portion of the procedure.

Permit Reissue Fees

During the program period expired offsite permits will be reissued for minimum fees:

The minimum fees are detailed as follows:

- \$50 for minor permits which include work that is less than 20 feet longitudinally or impact one travel lane.
- \$150 for an offsite permit related to a single residence.
- \$650 for all other offsite permits.

The permits will be reissued for a period of up to one year.

The program will be in effect until December 31, 2010.
