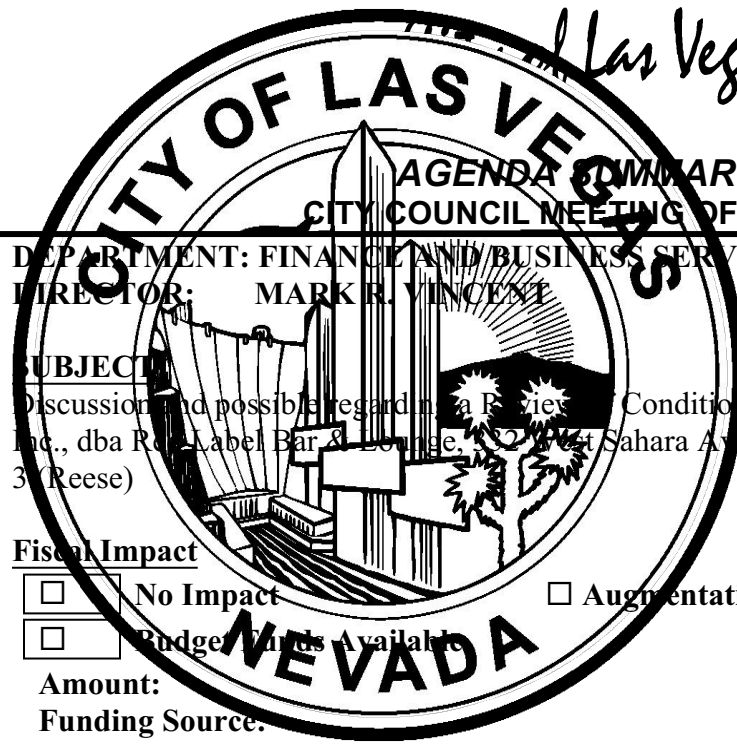

Motion made by GARY REESE to Approve subject to the following conditions as read for the record:

1. Entertainment allowed will include karaoke, comedy, live bands, birthdays, weddings and wedding receptions.
2. Entertainment will be limited to Thursday, Friday or Saturday nights from 6:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. for ages 21 and over for a six-month period.
3. Live bands to be limited to Friday or Saturday nights only, for a six-month period.
4. Entertainment for the week will be submitted to Business Services each Monday for review and approval.
5. No outdoor events will be allowed.

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6. DJ must be an employee of the Red Label Bar and Lounge. No outside DJs or promoters will be allowed.

7. The manager or designee may immediately suspend the entertainment venue if violations of the conditions are found pending a review of the tavern license at the next available City Council meeting.

8. There shall be a six-month review.

Minutes:

CAROL MEYER, Business Services Supervisor, explained that the Red Label Bar was approved for a temporary license in December of 2009 with conditions. The applicant has asked that the item be brought back earlier to have a review of those conditions.

MS. MEYER read the proposed conditions. ATTORNEY LANCE HENDERON appeared with NELY and BORIS PETKOVA, and asked to include Wednesdays as an additional day for entertainment. COUNCILMAN REESE expressed concerns about how the business might impact the surrounding residential area. He indicated that after the six-month review, consideration may be given to allow additional days.

MR. PETKOVA, General Manager, asked if it would be possible to have the review in three months instead of six because the budget was set to include live entertainment. He would appreciate any help.

COUNCILMAN REESE stated he is willing to revisit this in four months, but requested that the six-month review remain.
