Minutes:

JIM DiFIORE, Manager of Business Services, explained that a year ago RONALD SMITH appealed his work card based on a misdemeanor conviction that took place in 1998 in the State of California. The conviction was overturned in 2001 by the Supreme Court of California but remained on his record. Over the last year, MR. SMITH has made attempts to have the conviction pardoned by the Governor of California. Today's action is a review and to provide the City Council with an update.

MR. SMITH stated he is employed at Marche Bacchus as a server and has been trying to get his conviction overturned. Unfortunately, it is taking longer than expected. He has been in contact with his attorney and he was told his case is being reviewed, but it might be September before a decision is made. He clarified for MAYOR GOODMAN that in 2001 he applied to have his

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record expunged in California, which he was granted, but for some reason it has not been taken off the record.

MR. DiFIORE recommended a permanent work card site specific to Marche Bacchus, as he believes the technical issues will be addressed. MR. SMITH has had no problems and has the support of his employers.

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY stated that Marche Bacchus is a wonderful restaurant, and was pleased that the owner supports MR. SMITH.
