PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

In 2005, the Complete Streets Coalition was formed to advocate for and track the adoption of Complete Streets projects, as well as state and local Complete Streets policies and standards. In those few years, the Complete Street initiative has spread to over 100 cities, states and other jurisdictions who have adopted Complete Street policies. This resolution establishes a clear policy that the city should integrate and implement Complete Streets as a guiding principle for public improvement design and construction. The guiding principle of Complete Streets is to promote a safe network of access for pedestrians, bicyclists, motorists and transit riders of all ages and abilities. In the design and development of transportation infrastructure, the city shall endeavor to include within nonmotorized network plans, at a minimum, reasonable accommodations for accessibility, sidewalks, curb ramps and cuts, signage and bike lanes, in order to maximize walkable and bikeable streets within the city.
