PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This agreement provides for full service construction management, inspections, environmental coordination, material testing and project closeout of the installation of pre-fabricated steel pedestrian crossings and approximately 1/2 mile of pedestrian trail improvements. This project is funded by the Southern Nevada Public Land Management Act (SNPLMA).

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Minutes:

Regarding Items 32 and 33, COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN pointed out that the trail bridges have been in the works for over 10 years and is part of the City's Master Plan Trail Element. Previous members of the City Council approved this plan, and it would be difficult to deny the trail system given the fact that portions to the north and south of the site have been completed, leaving only the middle portion to complete. In addition, millions of dollars and hard work would be lost if this item is not approved. Despite some residents concerns relating to the proximity to residential, the trails will ultimately be a benefit to the neighborhood.

Regarding Item 33, KATHY RAININ, Manager of Purchasing and Contracts, corrected the bid amount, which should reflect \$4,657,593.57; the contingency amount should reflect \$465,759.00.
