Minutes:

Prior to hearing Item 71, MAYOR GOODMAN announced that an agreement was not reached between the City of Las Vegas and the Las Vegas City Employees Association. The Council has advised CITY MANAGER ELIZABETH FRETWELL to further reduce the Fiscal Year 2011 budget aggressively due to the shortfall resulting from labor costs and declining revenues. He gave credit to the executive and appointive employees on being the first to step up this time to address the shortfalls. As the Mayor, he does not want to leave the city in a terrible state for the next group of elected officials; it is their duty to bring finances in line with the private sector and to remain sustainable.
