Minutes:

After the Mayor read the comments he made earlier during the AM Session of this meeting, COUNCILMAN REESE stated he has worked closely with the leadership of the Las Vegas City Employees Association (LVCEA) and prefers not to see anyone laid off. With the recent vote from the LVCEA, he feels that it increases the heavy burden upon the City Council in making very tough decisions. ATTORNEY BRUCESNYDER, counsel for the LVCEA, added that the LVCEA simply wanted a guarantee that its union members would not be laid off if certain concessions were made. MAYOR GOODMAN responded that the City could not make that commitment, given the economy and its uncertainty.

COUNCILMAN WOLFSON announced this Saturday, April 24th is Earth Fair Day, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Walmart, located on Rainbow Boulevard at the 215 Freeway. On May 1st, there will be a Summerlin Colossal Clean-Up at the west end of Far Hills Drive and 215 Freeway. Volunteers are welcomed and additional information is on the website, www.summerlin.com. Lastly, May 8th at 9:00 a.m., the Councilman, along with COUNCILMAN ANTHONY, will be celebrating the Angel Park Trailhead opening at Durango Drive, between Westcliff Drive and Summerlin Parkway.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW invited everyone to attend Movie in the Park, hosted by Ward 5, at Lorenzi Park. The movie, Wally, will be shown in the Sammy Davis, Jr. Amphitheater, and the doors will open at 6:30 p.m. Another Earth Fair Day event will be held at the Walmart on Cheyenne Avenue and Rainbow Boulevard on April 28th. On this same day, the Councilman will ride his bike to work to celebrate Nevada Moves Day in supporting safe routes to school for children, and he encouraged everyone to ride their bikes on that day. Regarding the Neighborhood Preservation Fund, he invited individuals to visit his link on the City's website for up-to-date information and an upcoming workshop. His next Coffee with the Councilman will be on May 6th at Starbucks on Bonanza Road and Rancho Drive.

On behalf of COUNCILMAN ROSS, COUNCILMAN REESE invited everyone to the upcoming Helldorado events beginning May 16th.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN also announced Ward 1s Earth Fair Day on April 24th, and shredder machines will be available at each location.

Prior to adjourning the meeting, WILLIAM SANDERS asked for MAYOR GOODMAN'S tag; the Mayor offered a Las Vegas poker chip and pen to MR. SANDERS.
