Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN called CITY CLERK BEVERLY K. BRIDGES to the podium to declare Municipal Clerk's Week and presented her with a proclamation to recognize the important role that Municipal Clerks play in local government. Municipal Clerks exist throughout the world and provide a professional link between the citizens and local governing bodies. Along with all her duties here at the City, CITY CLERK BRIDGES also serves as the President of the Nevada Municipal Clerks Association, and will play a big role in hosting the annual conference for the International Institute of Municipal Clerks (IIMC) beginning May 23 in Northern Nevada.

MS. BRIDGES stated that the 64th IIMC annual conference is being hosted in Reno/Tahoe by the Nevada Municipal Clerks Association. This conference attracts approximately 1,000 delegates from every state in the United States and 15 other countries, including Canada, Australia and South Africa. Every year the conference focuses on promoting continuing education and professional development within the profession and to provide access to the latest available technology which benefits respective cities and towns.

The IIMC was founded in 1947 and works year around to provide a variety of programs and services to all its 10,000 members, including Certified Municipal Clerks and the Master Municipal Clerks programs. She received her Master last year. She is proud to be a member of the IIMC and thanked the Mayor and City Council for their support and for taking the time to recognize this organization.
