MAYOR GOODMAN invited GLENN NORTON of the National Association of Letter Carriers to the podium. Every year letter carriers across the country conduct a food drive as part of the Stamp Out Hunger campaign. The food they collect goes to families in need, and in these tough economic times the extra help that this food drive provides becomes even more important.

This Saturday, May 8th, the letter carriers will be collecting food across the country, and to recognize such a great endeavor, MAYOR GOODMAN presented MR. NORTON with a proclamation recognizing May 8th as National Association of Letter Carriers Food Drive Day in the City of Las Vegas. MR. NORTON thanked the Mayor and Council and presented the Mayor with a T-shirt. The food drive is in its 20th year, and people are encouraged to leave non-perishable items by their mailboxes or on top of a community mailbox to be picked up by the letter carriers. People can also purchase pre-packaged bags for \$9.99 at any Albertsons Supermarkets or donate non-perishable items to any Good Will store. The food will be delivered to food banks across the Valley.
