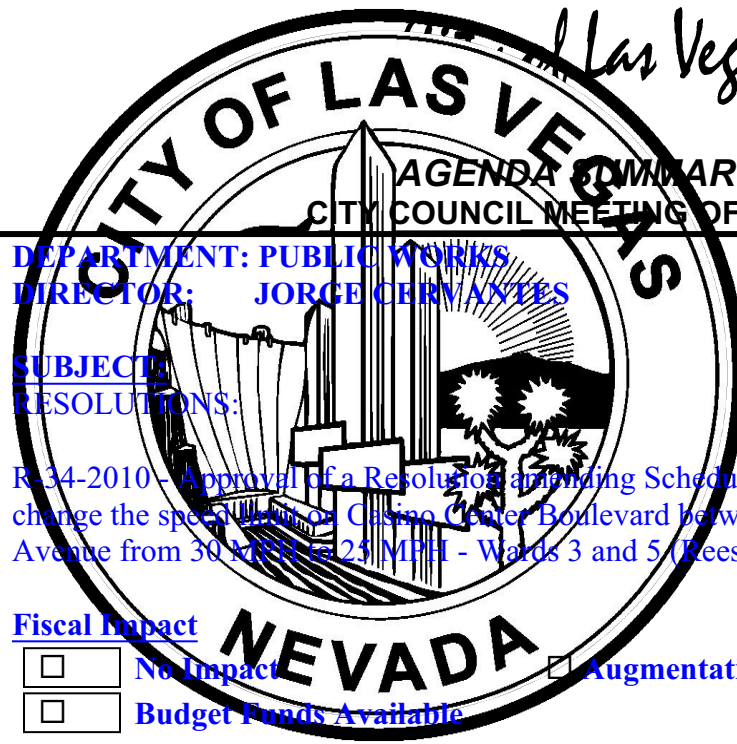

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Traffic Engineering Division is recommending that the speed limit on Casino Center Boulevard between Charleston Boulevard and Stewart Avenue be lowered from 30 mph to 25 mph. With the Regional Transportation Commissions Bus Rapid Transit project running along Casino Center Boulevard, this street has been converted to only a single travel lane in each direction; previously it had two travel lanes in each direction. The design also required the use of narrower lanes. Now that it has been converted into a transit corridor, it also attracts more pedestrians. The lower speed limit will be more appropriate because of the unique operation of a center-running transit system and the increase in pedestrian traffic. We therefore recommend a 25 mph speed limit.
