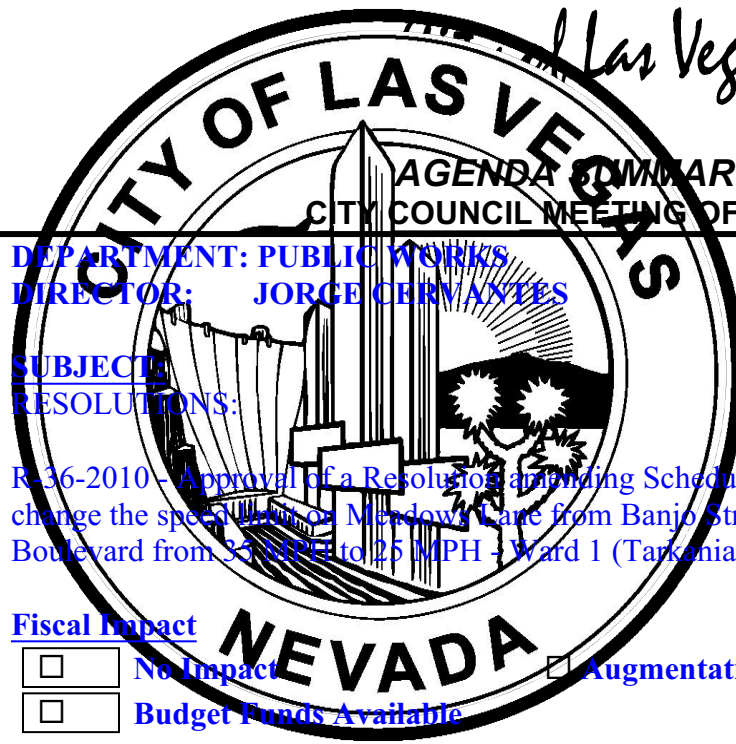

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The speed limit on Meadows Lane from Decatur Boulevard to Banjo Street is presently 35 mph. The Traffic Engineering Division is recommending that the speed limit on Meadows Lane from Banjo Street to 1300 feet west of Decatur Boulevard be lowered from 35 mph to 25 mph. Residents from the senior housing on the south side of the street and from the apartment complex on the north side of the street cross Meadows Lane at the crosswalk at Promenade Boulevard to visit the stores in that area, and vehicles come too fast for them to cross the street safely. There is also a curve in the roadway that causes a sight distance problem for both pedestrians and drivers.
