PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Neighborhood Partners Fund Board was established through Council action in June of 1998 to review Neighborhood Partners Fund applications and make funding recommendations to the City Council. The bylaws were amended in February of 2000 to increase the number of members from 9 to 13 and again in March 2009 to adjust the commencement date for member terms to April 1 while maintaining the duration of each term to one year. This amendment is a housekeeping measure to clarify that members need not be City residents.
