in the City of Las Vegas and ask our citizens to join us in recognizing them for their 100 years of service to this community and across America



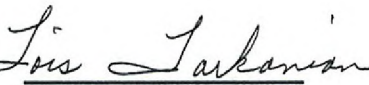

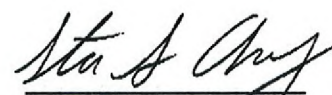
